



End Of The Line



White Chunk Pumpkin Cake

3 cups buttermilk baking mix

1½ cups granulated sugar

2½ teaspoons ground cinnamon

1 cup canned pumpkin

2 eggs, lightly beaten

½ cup John Henry 3 Lick Spiker Ale

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

3 bars (6 ounce) white baking bars

2/3 cup chopped pecans, coarsely chopped

(1) Stir together baking mix, sugar, and cinnamon in a large bowl. Stir in pumpkin, eggs, John Henry 3 Lick Spiker Ale, and vanilla extract just until moistened. Stir in ½ of the baking bars and ½ of the pecans. Spread into greased 13 x 9 inch baking pan.

(2) Bake in preheated 350°F. oven for 20 minutes. Sprinkle with remaining baking bars and remaining pecans. Bake for 10 to 15 minutes more or until wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely in a pan or wire rack.

Serve with a John Henry 3 Lick Spiker Ale.
